GUIDANCE NOTES

STATUS DISCOUNT: APPRENTICES, STUDENT NURSES AND YOUTH TRAINING TRAINEES

An **apprentice** a person who is:

- learning a trade, profession, vocation etc.
- undertaking a training program that is accredited by the National Council for Vocational Qualifications or the Scottish equivalent, and
- is receiving an allowance or salary less than would be paid if qualified and, in any case less than £160.00 a week.

A **student nurse** is a person who is:

- attending a college of nursing and midwifery, or
- a college of health, and
- the course, if successfully completed, would lead to first registration on the Register maintained under section 10 or the Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitors Act 1979.

A **youth training trainee** is a person who is:

- under the age of 25 years, and undertaking training under arrangements that constitute an approved training scheme as defined in section 28 (6) (c) or the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992.
