Notice of revised penalty charges for parking contraventions

The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (Guidelines on Levels of Charges) (England) Order 2007 ("the Order") requires that from 31 March 2008 the current flat rate penalty charge for parking contraventions shall be replaced by 2 different levels of penalty charge, a higher level penalty charge and a lower level penalty charge according to the seriousness of the parking contravention.

Salisbury District Council in exercise of its powers under the Traffic Management Act 2004 has set the levels of penalty charge payable for off street parking contraventions in the District of Salisbury Civil Enforcement Area in accordance with Band 2 of Table 1 to the Order.

The amended penalty charge payable on issue of a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN) will be

1. Higher level parking contravention - £70
2. Lower level parking contravention - £50

The penalty charges are discounted by 50% if payment is received within 14 days of the issue of the PCN to £35 (higher level) and £25 (lower level).

If the penalty charge remains unpaid after 28 days from the issue of the PCN it will increase by 50% on service of a Charge Certificate to £105 (higher level) and £75 (lower level).

The higher level penalty charge will be payable for the off street parking contraventions prescribed in Table 3 of the Schedule to the Order.

The lower level penalty charge will be payable for all other off street parking contraventions. The schedule below lists current off street parking contraventions. Other contraventions may be added pursuant to paragraph 5 of schedule 7 of the Traffic Management Act 2004.

This Notice is given further to paragraph 9 of Schedule 9 to the Traffic Management Act 2004 which requires publication of the level of charges set in accordance with the Order.

A copy of this notice and Table 3 of the Order are available for inspection at the council's office at Pennyfarthing House, Pennyfarthing Street, Salisbury SP1 3UY, between 9am and 5pm Monday to Friday and on the council's website at www.salisbury.gov.uk.

The Order and revised penalty charges come into effect on 31 March 2008.

Parked in a loading area during restricted hours without reasonable excuse	Higher	Off-street loading areas
Parked without payment of the parking charge	Lower	Off-street car parks
Using a vehicle in a parking place in connection with the sale or offering or exposing for sale of goods when prohibited	Higher	Off-street car parks

Parked for longer than the maximum period permitted	Lower	Off-street car parks
Parked in a restricted area in a car park	Higher	Off-street car parks
Parked after the expiry of paid for time	Lower	Off-street car parks
Parked in a car park without clearly displaying a valid pay & display ticket or voucher or parking clock	Lower	Off-street car parks
Parked with additional payment made to extend the stay beyond time first purchased	Lower	Off-street car parks
Parked in a permit bay without clearly displaying a valid permit	Higher	Off-street car parks
Parked beyond the bay markings	Lower	Off-street car parks
Parked in a designated disabled person's parking place without displaying a valid disabled person's badge in the prescribed manner	Higher	Off-street car parks
Vehicle parked exceeds maximum weight or height or length permitted in the area	Higher	Off-street car parks
Re-parked within one hour* of leaving a bay or space in a car park	Lower	Off-street car parks
Parked in a car park or area not designated for that class of vehicle	Higher	Off-street car parks
Parked causing an obstruction	Higher	Off-street car parks
Parked in car park when closed	Lower	Off-street car parks
Parked in a pay & display car park without clearly displaying two**** valid pay and display tickets when required	Lower	Off-street car parks
Parked in a parking place for a purpose other than the designated purpose for the parking place	Lower	Off-street car parks
Parked with engine running where prohibited	Lower	Off-street car parks - this contravention may occur in certain coach bays.
